# The New 730 Area Code is Coming to the Illinois 618 Area Code Region

To ensure a continuing supply of telephone numbers, the Illinois Commerce Commission has approved an all-services overlay for the 618 area code. The 618 area code serves southern Illinois including the larger cities of Belleville, O'Fallon, Alton, and Carbondale in addition to many smaller communities. The new 730 area code will serve the same geographic area currently served by the 618 area code. An overlay is the addition of another area code (730) to the same geographic region as an existing area code (618). It does not require you to change your existing area code or phone number, or how you dial your calls.

Beginning July 7, 2023, customers in the 618 area code region may be assigned a number in the new 730 area code when they request new service or an additional line. Customers receiving the 730 area code will be required to dial the area code and phone number for all local calls, just as customers with telephone numbers from the 618 area code do today.

The price of a call, coverage area, or other rates and services will not change due to the overlay. You will continue to dial 10 digits for local calls within and between the overlay area codes, and 1 + 10 digits for long distance calls.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) continue to enforce the regulations for the National Do-Not-Call List. The FCC requires all telecommunications carriers that provide Local Exchange Service to notify the subscribers of their rights as they relate to the Do-Not-Call rules. You have the right to give or revoke an objection to receiving telephone solicitations. To either register or revoke your registration, please call 888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236) or via the Internet at donotcall.gov.

The national registry prevents telephone solicitations made for commercial purposes only, and will not prevent telephone solicitations made by a tax-exempt nonprofit organizations, for example, for charitable or political purposes. Also, the registry will not prevent calls from companies with whom you may have an established business relationship, or those to whom you've provided express agreement in writing to receive their calls.

The FCC has defined an established business relationship as one in which the consumer has "a prior or existing relationship" with a company that is formed voluntarily through communications between the company and consumer on the basis of purchase or transaction regarding products or services within 18 months immediately preceding a telephone solicitation, and which has not been previously terminated by either the consumer or the company. Such an established business relationship also exists on the basis of a consumer inquiry regarding a company's products or services within three months immediately preceding the date of a telephone solicitation, and which either the consumer or the company has not previously terminated.

ffective on your February 2023 statement, the amount of your Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) appearing on your bill each month will change in the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) universal service fund contribution factor from 28.9% to 32.6%. The federal universal service fund program is designed to help keep local telephone service rates affordable for all customers.
