Nominating Committee meets

Mr. Arbeiter reviewed cooperative bylaws and policies pertaining in the committee's responsibilities and duties from nominating candidates. Lowell Shubert was elected chairman and Kenneth

FUSC charge

Effective on your August 2026 statement, the amount of your Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) appearing on your bill each month will change in the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) universal service fund contribution factor from 37.0% to 38.8%. The federal universal service fund is designed to help keep local telephone service rates affordable for all customers in all areas of the United States.

Egyptian distributes approximately \$250,000 in capital credits
